SEVERNA PARK – In order to better serve the residents of Anne Arundel County, AAWDC is moving its One-Stop Career Center and program services to the third floor of the George M. Taylor District Court Multi-Service Center located at 7500 Gov. Ritchie Highway in Glen Burnie. The move will combine the offices of the Anne Arundel Workforce Development Corporation and Glen Burnie’s Maryland Job Service and unify the services offered to County residents. The One-Stop Career Center’s new phone number will be 410.412.7000.

“For us, it’s about making our client-focused career services more accessible; the Severna Park location wasn’t adequately meeting our clients’ needs. We’ve restructured our approach to program services and will still provide high quality workforce solutions for job seekers and employers. The George M. Taylor District Court Multi-Service Center building is in the heart of Glen Burnie's revitalized downtown business community, near La Fontaine Bleu and the Glen Burnie Town Center. Free parking is available in the parking lot in front of the building and the adjacent parking garage. The Taylor building is on the MTA #14 and #210 bus routes.

According to Crystal Martin, AAWDC's operations manager, AAWDC's Administrative Offices will relocate to 401 Headquarters Drive, Suite 205 in Millersville, MD in mid-June. Presently, AAWDC has three satellite One-Stop Career Centers in Annapolis, Odenton, and Arundel Mills with plans to open two additional One-Stops in the Deale-Churchton area and BWI Airport.
