### Host a Senior Aide in Your Workplace

MILLERSVILLE – It's been almost one year since the Anne Arundel Workforce Development Corporation (AAWDC) began administering Anne Arundel County's Senior AIDES program, and already the program has saved local community service agencies and nonprofits approximately \$120,193 in labor costs. And, the program is hoping to help your organization.

Your organization may be eligible to receive a Senior Aide placement if it is nonprofit or government agency. The County's Senior AIDES (Alert Industrious Dedicated Energetic Service) program connects low-income seniors (55 and older) with subsidized part-time positions in organizations such as libraries, schools, fire and police departments, parks and recreation offices, churches, and nutrition programs. It's a win-win situation for all parties involved: seniors learn marketable job skills and their host agencies receive great employees at no cost.
